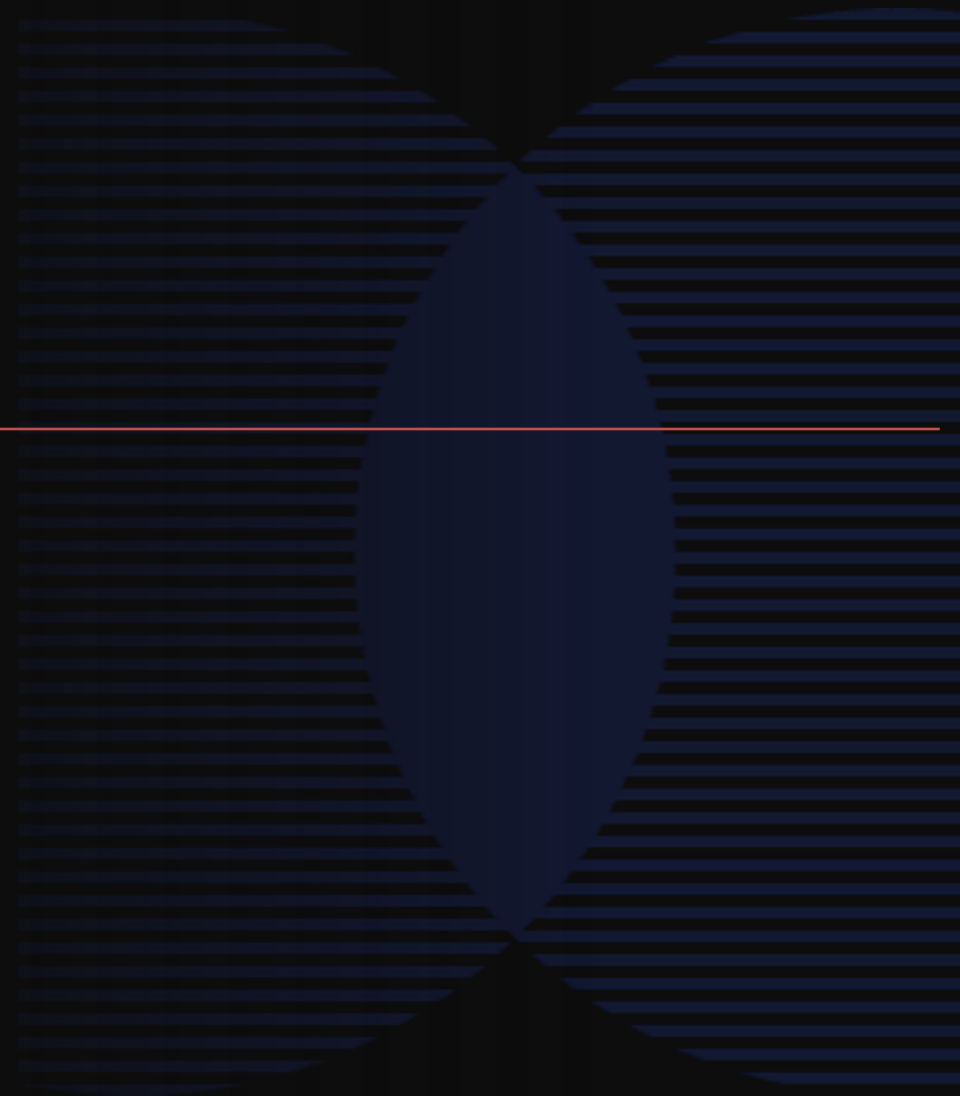


STUDENT VISA – Korea





GENERAL INFORMATION

STUDENT VISA (D2)

With this visa, you can:

- Students may travel overseas during their stay in **Korea** and subsequently return to continue their studies
- You may apply for a part-time job permit to the immigration (branch) office and engage in the job once granted the permit.
- Work up to 20 hours per week once your course starts
- Salary fee for student internship and part time KRW8,500 / hour (average)



LENGTH OF STAY

Length of stay

- **The period of sojourn (length of stay) is granted in accordance with the duration of studies as listed in the Certificate of Admission**
- **Maximum length of stay up to 2 years**



FEES

Student visa fee

- Changes from time to time
- Current Online visa fee USD160

Additional costs:

- **Medical Insurance**



DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

1. Completed visa application form and one coloured, passport-sized photo (white background)
2. Passport with at least 6 months remainder validity and one blank "visa" page (original and copy)
3. Certificate of admission from host university
4. Certificate of business registration (사업자등록증명) of the host university.
5. Recent 3 months Indonesia bank account statement
6. Health Condition Report Form
7. Agreement to Facility Quarantine
8. Test scores that your college required, such as the TOEFL
